It's a free, online forum (login required) meant to be used in higher education. It has some useful additional features (e.g. uploading resources, results, sharing lecture notes/slides. It notifies the user via email about new questions or instructor's notes, if appears – the frequency of updates can be predefined in user's profile (we suggest using *smart digest*, in every two hours), the mobile platform also offers push notifications.

WHAT WE USE IT FOR

This is our primary communication platform, it comes before emails – it means, you usually get an answer sooner via piazza, either from your classmates or the instructors. We prefer open questions for it allows discussion. We post all relevant updates about the course on piazza.




